Contributions are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Federal election law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year. Contributions from corporations, foreign nationals and government contractors are prohibited.

The Kennedy Majority Committee is a joint fundraising committee established on behalf of the John Kennedy for U.S. Senate, Inc. ("Campaign") and the National Republican Senatorial Committee ("NRSC"). Joint fundraising proceeds shall be allocated according to the following formula: (i) The first \$2,300 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the first \$5,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, shall be allocated to the Campaign's primary election account, (ii) The next \$2,300 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the next \$5,000 of any contribution by a multicandidate federal PAC, shall be allocated to the Campaign's general election account, and (iii) The remaining \$28,500 of any contribution by an individual or non-multicandidate federal PAC, or the remaining \$15,000 of any contribution from a multicandidate federal PAC, shall be allocated to the NRSC. Notwithstanding this allocation formula, a contributor may designate his or her contribution for a particular participant. In addition, the allocation formula may change if a contributor makes a contribution which would exceed the amount that the contributor may give to a particular participant.
